A happy and healthy summer to all! A few things to remember...

A current physical exam (dated after 9/2017) is required for 10th graders, for interscholastic sports and working papers! Physical forms were mailed home with the report cards.

For Athletic Physical Examinations

Students wishing to participate in competitive sports are required to have a physical examination in advance of the sport. This examination must be done within one year prior to the beginning of the official start date of the sport. Physical examinations this summer will be done at Bailey Middle School fulfill the requirement for all sports during the next school year. Athletic examinations may be done by the school physician or the student's physician. The school physician performs examinations at KHS between July 1st and August 15th. **Call the KHS medical office for an appointment at 845-943-3742.**

* **Physical examinations done by the student's physician** must be completed at least two weeks prior to the beginning of the sport. The **HEALTH EXAM FORM** will be mailed with the report cards and it must be filled out entirely (both sides) and returned to the Coleman Health Office. Incomplete forms or missing paperwork will delay the student from participation in the sport and will be returned to the student.
