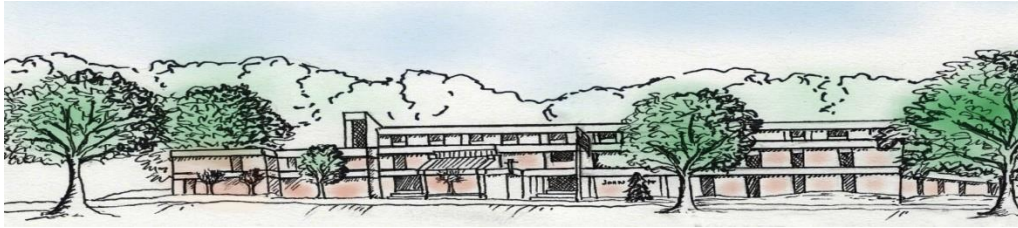
- **Senior:** case of water or soda
