**JUNIOR CLASS RECOGNITION:** As a school community, we will recognize the junior class as they receive the symbols of their entry into senior year. Rings & pins will be distributed to all juniors on May 15 at 1:00pm in the chapel. We will also recognize juniors who are eligible for National Honor Society. Students must meet the four criteria of scholarship, service, leadership, and character to be inducted into the Coleman Honor Society. **YEAR-END REMINDERS:** All financial obligations for Coleman students must be satisfied before final exams. Senior exams begin on May 28. Final exams for underclassmen begin on June 18. **Students will not be admitted to final exams if tuition and fees for this school year are still owed to the school.** Seniors will not be eligible to participate in graduation if final exams are not taken.

**REGISTRATION FOR 2019-2020:** Course selection for next year has been completed. Parents will receive the tuition management form from FACTS in the next few weeks. Unpaid registration fees will be added to tuition.

Sports Awards: this ceremony will be held in the cafeteria on May 29 at 6:30 pm.

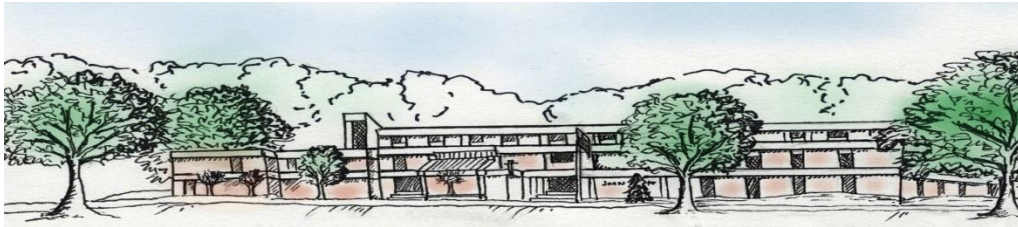
Baccalaureate: will be held on June 6 and Junior parents are needed to assist in the serving dinner and for clean-up.
